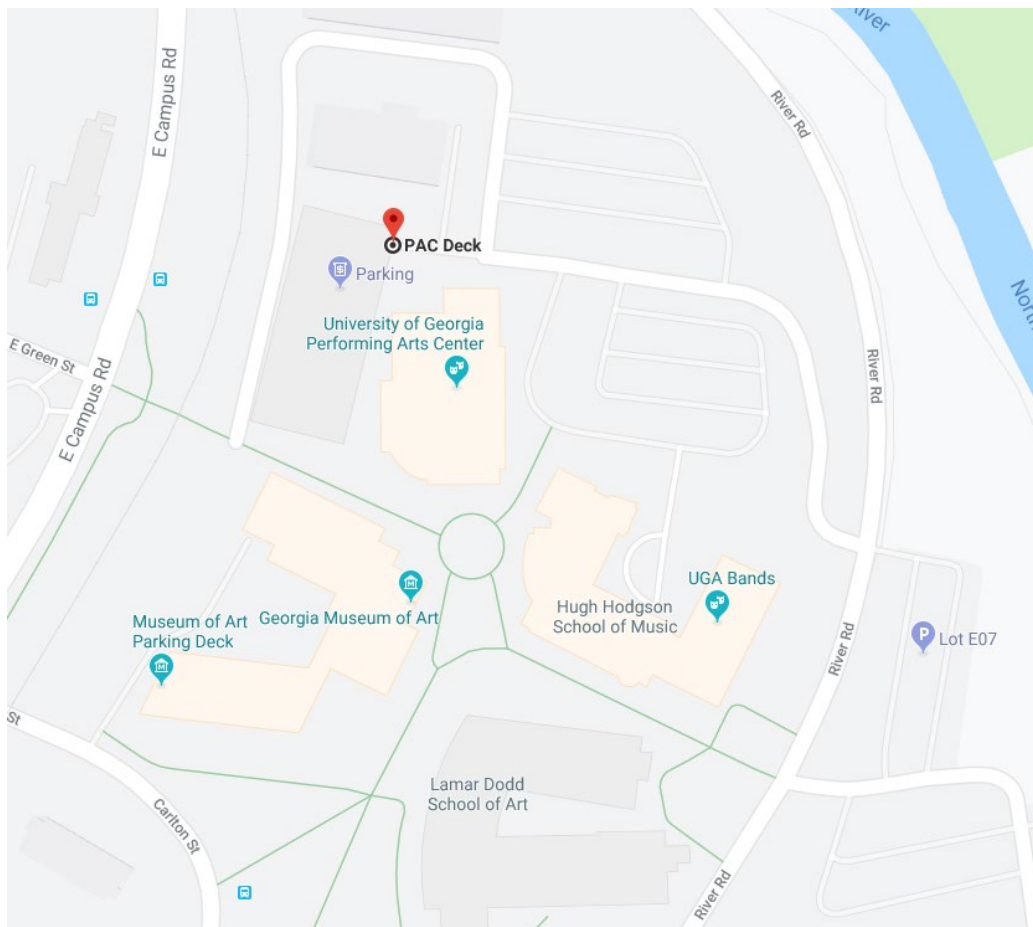
Tuesday, August 6

The meeting will take place at the Georgia Museum of Art: <http://georgiamuseum.org/>
The address is 90 Carlton Street, Athens, GA 30602.

Parking for the Georgia Museum of Art is available in the Performing Arts Center (PAC) parking deck that is off River Rd and at the rear of lot E11. The address to the PAC deck is 220 River Rd.

There is a meter on the first floor of the parking deck and **you must know your license plate number to use the meter!**

Parking is free if you use the coupon validation code: **GMO5232**. To use the code, you will press the yellow button, enter the code and confirm, enter your license plate and confirm, review your order and confirm, then take printed receipt.





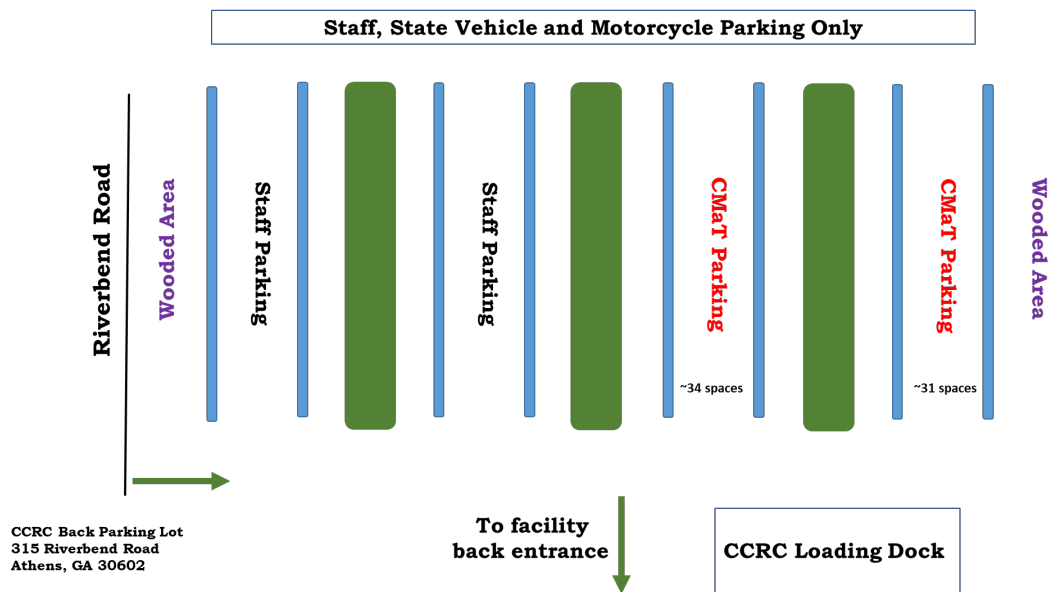
Wednesday, August 7 – Thursday, August 8

The meeting will take place at the Complex Carbohydrate Research Center:

When you turn into the main drive off Riverbend Road stay straight and the parking area will be on your left (across from the back of the CCRC facility). There are 4 'lanes' into the parking areas. CMaT participants are asked to go to the parking slots in the lower two parking 'lanes'. Participants can access the facility by following the sidewalk to the back entrances (the sidewalk runs beside the loading dock area). Once inside the facility the hallways will lead to the 1st floor lobby area (outside the auditorium).

Attire:

The dress code for the retreat is casual. However, we request that you do not wear shorts or flip-flops. We want everyone to be comfortable – jeans, khakis, slacks, T-shirts and other comfortable clothing are fine.



Wifi:

1. Navigate to the wi-fi settings area of the device you're trying to connect and select UGA_Visitors_Wifi from the list.
2. After selecting UGA_Visitors_Wifi, your device should open up a web browser for you to sign in to. If it does not do this automatically, navigate to the web browser and try to access a website of your choosing. The browser should automatically redirect you to the UGA access portal.
3. You should see two options for gaining authorization on this network: email or SMS text. A verification code will be sent to you via one of these options.
4. Choose your verification option, enter the appropriate contact information and proceed to the next page. You will receive a verification code via email or text, which you must enter in to the box provided. You are now connected to the network.

Transportation:

Commercial ground service is available from the Hartsfield-Jackson Airport in Atlanta to Athens and the University of Georgia. For the shuttle schedule and fare information call 1-800-896-9928 or go to <https://groometransportation.com/athens/>

We will provide **shuttle bus transportation from the Hyatt Place Hotel to the conference locations** each day. The shuttle schedule is below and on the agenda. There is limited parking at both the museum and CCRC so participants are encouraged to carpool or ride the shuttle.

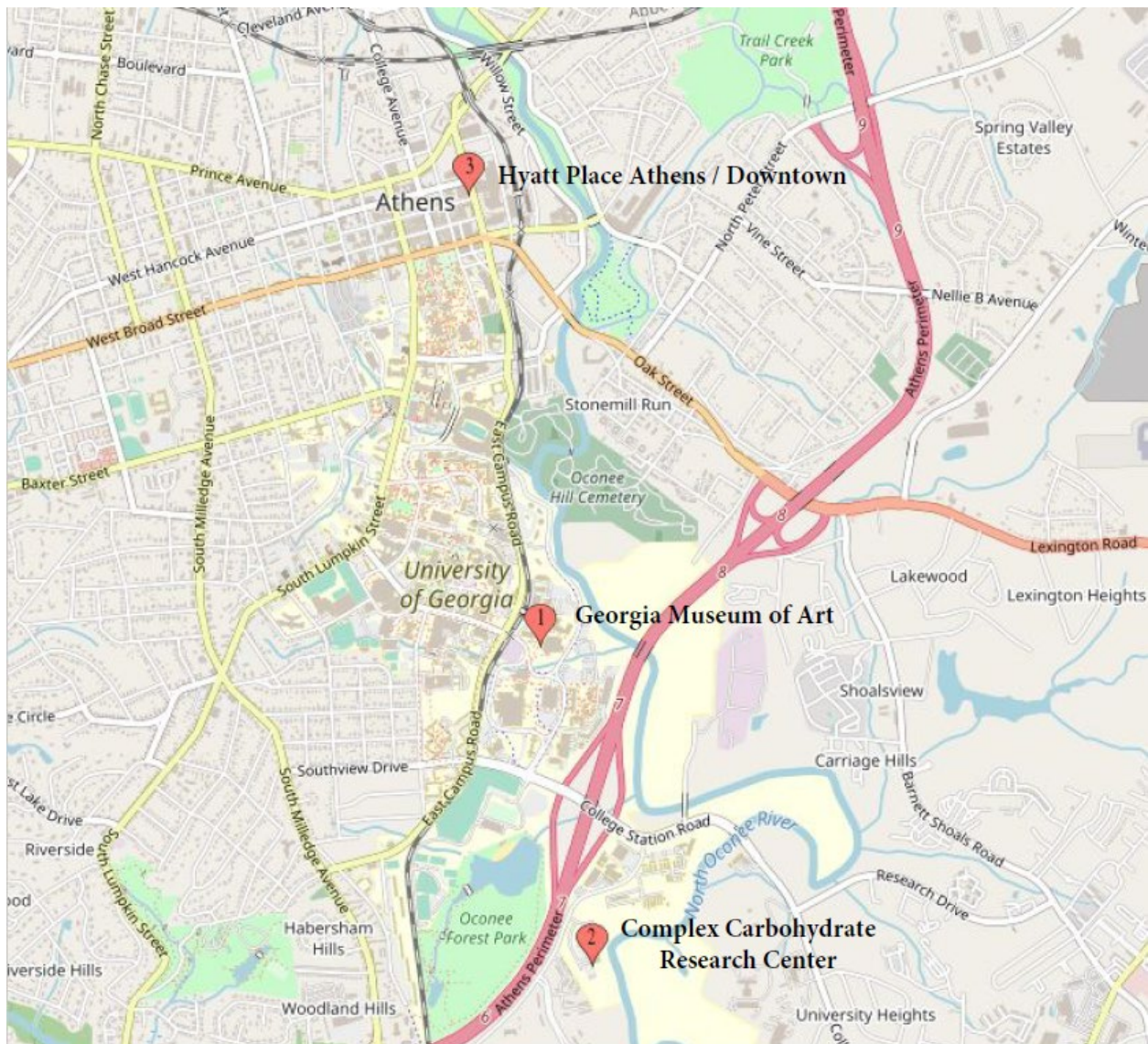
